“CHRIST CENTRED FAMILY” BY PASTOR YEMISI BAMGBOSE



I TIMOTHY 3:1-13; JEREMIAH 31:1; PSALM 127:1-5

Christ centred family is a family that has made Jesus Christ the centre of their life, home and wellbeing. They give priority to the word of God, meditate and obey it. Their standard of living is based on Christ and the bible alone. The family that has Christ at the centre of their everyday lives. Where Jesus reigns and rules. A Christ centred family is a family that honours God in all that they do. The parents see their responsibility in promoting Christian values and virtues in their home. Their home is the formation of talents, skills, aspirations, desires and leadership, where well balanced training is given to their children, their home is a place of safety, security and centre of developing creativity and transmission of values such as the importance of people, relationship, love, moral standing, honesty and spiritual values. It is also a breeding ground of creativity and a place of safety and security. Where the parents refuse to surrender their children to the problem they encounter in life. Their home is not used for the ground of growing hatred and disunity. A Christ centred family is expected to be at peace with each other and live in peace with others, this can only be achieved when relationship between parents is cordial and relationship between parents and the children especially the grown-up children is also cordial. It is a family that has chosen the path of obedience to Jesus Christ. God expects a Christian child, teenager or adult, still living with their parents or on their own not to conform to the behaviour of the world they live in, but in all manner of behaviour honour Christ their Lord and Master.

Romans 12:2

As a family, we all have certain responsibilities to perform, which might not be required of an unbelieving youths, for example, it is a scriptural command that children must obey their parents in the Lord, it is dangerous to disobey your parents, except when their instructions contravene scriptural commandment.

Ephesians 6:1

The survival of Christianity and the betterment of the society depends on a Christ centred family that promotes Christian values and ethos.

Parents should employ godly wisdom, wisdom in the number of children they give birth to. In addition, wisdom to manage resources, money, time and energy investing in training their children according to the perfect will of God.

I Timothy 5:8

Parents should know that their children are gifts from God and should be treated as such. **Psalm 127:1**

Parents should love God and they must be seen as loving God sincerely and they must in turn train their children to love God especially from young age.

Love must be seen to be demonstrated in your home.

A Christ centred family will achieve success only when there is genuine repentance and all members of the family avail themselves of the grace of God by spending quality time together in prayer, devotion and in studying the bible.

They must dedicate sufficient time in studying the bible and fellowship with other believers.

The Christ centred family must leave nothing to chance as anything left to chance may become a breeding place for the devil to operate in their home.

Family devotional time should be made interesting, lively and all family members should actively participate in it.

Fathers should follow the example of father Abraham who God called His friend, because he obeyed God in all things, he gave his all to God to the point of his willingness in sacrificing his only son Isaac, God also knew that Abraham will train his children to love and to obey Him.

Genesis 18:19.

He took care of his family, provided for their needs and that of his servants, he listened to the counsel of his wife during a time of conflict within the family setting.

He left a good inheritance for his children's children, including all Christ followers.

He was also an intercessor as he interceded for Sodom and Gomorrah.

He was a wise man, he clearly demonstrated this by asking his nephew Lot to make a choice before himself when their herdsmen quarrelled.

Genesis 13:8-11

The mothers in the Christ centred family also should follow the good example of mother Sarah, who followed her husband wherever God led him.

She has reverence for her own husband, obeyed and loved him. She fully supported him to worship God, hence she was remembered by God.

1 Peter 3:6

Your family should be a model unto others around you in love, kindness, productivity, hospitality, holiness, godliness, obedience, forgiveness and faith.

Parents in Christ centred family should never take serious and delicate decisions alone without consulting God and with each other.

Seek advice from others in faith, not elders by age alone but elders by grace, good experience and anointing.

Parents should have the best interest of their family at heart and seek their welfare always.

Your good relationship must not be limited to the members of your nuclear family alone, must be extended even to the family in the church and community.

Seek to relate well with other members of your family and as well as others. It will be improper to divulge the secret of your family to an outsider. Do not criticise or condemn your family in front of members of other families.

Christ centred family relationship with God should be unquestionable as your love for God must be demonstrated for others to see and emulate.

That love must be clearly seen in your speech, words and actions.

Your home must not be a breeding ground for gossips, slandering or backbiting others, evil plans and evil communications.

The question we must always ask ourselves is, who is the one ruling your home, Christ or the devil?

Many supposed CHRIST centred family has ceased honouring God in their day to day life, many have stopped believing in Him, they have stopped training their children in the ways of The Lord. Many are choosing the easy option in neglecting the training of their children to others, allowing the society to mould and shape their children for them. Many no longer obey God in their homes, many have allowed the seed of the enemy, satan to take roots in their heart.

Some are even bearing evil report about others, some have used the gifts of God to promote the kingdom of the devil.

Some Christian families have taken oaths together to destroy the work of God, others are doing it unknowingly. Repent today and return to God, so that you may be healed.

Remember the law of harvest, whatsoever a man sow, he shall reap, let's sow good seed so that we can reap a good harvest. **Galatians 6:7, Genesis 8:22**

If Jesus is in your family, it will be a happy happy home.

May the King of glory reign and rule in your home as you submit your home to His control in order to direct your family aright in Jesus name.






