NEW THINGS BY PASTOR YEMISI BAMGBOSE

ISAIAH 43:18-19



New things are what only God can do through His unchanging nature and Almighty power. A new thing is not an innovation from man or of man, but of God who is Sovereign, and only He can create and re-create.

What is a new thing? It refers to a fresh thing and a fresh start, a brand-new thing.

Psalm 72:12-14

New things are heaven's response to human limitations here on earth.

When you feel trapped and completely overwhelmed in the old, new things are required. A detachment from the old, and separation from an unprofitable existence.

It refers to the latest, having not existed before now.

It is something brand new, a first time out.

It is something current and refers to the most recent.

It could mean a newborn, a new beginning or new birth.

New things are things that God has not done before.

Isaiah 48:6-7

There must have been an old thing before the new can commence.

God is declaring new things into our lives and families.

We also know that His declaration cannot be hidden or covered.

It is clear that what God has legislated cannot be covered nor stopped.

The old must be put away completely before we can experience the new.

The God of all mercy is going to do many new things in our lives this year. God, out of the fullness of His compassion, is able to do something new.

But we must trust His judgement and faithfulness.

These new things will bring a complete shift to our identity, purpose, and behaviour.

The believer is no longer a slave to sin but is empowered by the Holy Spirit to live a life of righteousness and holiness.

Ephesians 4:22-24

There is a promise of a brand-new thing in your life.

A brand-new beginning will birth new things for you.

Because our past pain and captivity does not define our future.

Do not keep going on and ruminating about the past, whether it is defeat, failure or loss. Let go of the old story. Let go of past expectations not met, and people that have disappointed in the past - this should all be left behind.

There are old versions of one's self and behaviours that must go for the new things to take root in our lives.

Why do we require the new? It is because the old is no longer sufficient, and the old is not a position to be in forever.

The new ultimately cancels the old or former things.

Haggai 2:9

The old can be attributed to our sinful nature that drags us down to where we do not want to go or be.

God is promising many of us new ideas, new territories, new strategies, new skills, new and unused talents, and new ways of maximising our talents.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Whenever there is a spiritual birth, God is doing new things.

Believers are no longer in condemnation, as we stand in the grace of God.

Jesus established a New Covenant, offering direct access to God through His blood, unlike the limited access of the Old Covenant.

This new way of relating to God is through faith in Jesus, not just adherence to the Law.

God is calling us to a new level of seeking His face and intercession.

God is challenging you to embrace the new things that may not be attractive in the beginning but will eventually pay off in spiritual promotion.

God has opened the life gates to His children that all may go in.

Lamentation 3:22-23

God's mercy is new every morning, and great is His faithfulness.

This mercy can make all things new, as God's mercies are new every morning.

God is merciful, and the law of mercy cancels judgement without apportioning blame.

Mercy can cause you to cross over from the side of condemnation to the other side of acceptance.

God, that has promised a new thing, is expecting us to let go of the old ways of life, in order to embrace the new things.

God can do new things in your health, home, spiritual walk, career, and business etc. A part of the new things can be a call to reformation and revolution, and a call to reset and rethink.

God is doing new things trans generationally by giving our youths new opportunities to exercise their faith.

Judges 3:1-3

God's new thing begins when we start drawing strength from Him.

Intellectual integrity may develop intellectual arrogance, and it suppresses intellectual and spiritual integrity.

Isaiah 48:6-7 - *"Thou hast heard, see all this; and will not ye declare it? I have shewed thee new things from this time, even hidden things, and thou didst not know them. They are created now, and not from the beginning; even before the day when thou heardest them not; lest thou shouldest say, Behold, I knew them."*

God is telling us that these new things are created now and not from the beginning.

God can bring newness into every stale situation of your life. He can end every oppression in a moment and cause new liberation to spring forth.

God's new things can give you wings to fly over mountains instead of walking around them. He can give you strength to bore a hole through the obstacle rather than trying to remove it.

God's new things can change the weak and feeble and make them more than conquerors to possess the gates of our cities and the seven mountains of influence.

God's new things can introduce drastic change to our economy, in politics, and in our cities.

There was a country that once was ruled by gangs that God turned around by the appointment of a godly president.

Prayers can bring nations to their knees. Prayers can move God to move the entire atmosphere to that of repentance.

Proverbs 29:2

Genesis 22:6

We must cooperate with God for the new things that are about to spring forth. New things in the place of prayer, fasting, relationship, and godly living.

We must not circumvent the process of these new things.

THE BLESSINGS OF THE NEW THINGS:

- New songs, and no more songs of captivity - **Psalm 40:1-3**
- Sudden and divine visitation
- Open heavens for your sake
- Change of location to allocation

PRAYER:

I see new things, I see a brighter day, I see an open door, I see new connections, I see you transformed, I see you lifted high and rejoicing.

I pray for you that all the Almighty God has in store for you will begin to manifest today, in the name of Jesus! Lord, You are truly doing new things, please do not leave me out and let me be completely part of it, in the name of Jesus.

Father, give me the grace to embrace a new beginning in every area of my life; spiritually, physically, mentally, and ministerially, in the name of Jesus.


